

# HEBREW STUDY TOOLS

## FINAL PROJECT

### RUBRIC

---

1. This project will be a selection of an Old Testament Passage of 5 – 10 verses in length. It needs to comprise a section of Scripture (e.g., Psalm 23 [6 verses]).
  2. You will present a formal paper in accordance with the Turabian 6<sup>th</sup> Edition Format.
  3. You will assemble your paper in the following manner:
    - a. Title Page
    - b. Blank Page
    - c. Table of Contents
    - d. Introduction [Write this last, it will summarize what you will address in your paper]
    - e. Context [This will be a discussion of the historical and biblical background to your passage; You will utilize a minimum of 15 sources which will be footnoted in this section NOTE: This is the only section where you will have footnotes]
    - f. Translation and Significant Word Studies [You will use one page per verse for translation and word studies. You will have to type the word study information. This will be a summary of what you discovered in the Theological Wordbook of the Old Testament. Please use black ink for the translation sheets and write neatly and as large as possible. Do not rush writing each of these verses out.]
    - g. Theological Reflection [You will answer the following questions for the passage as a whole {not verse by verse}: What does this passage say about:
      1. God
      2. Christ
      3. The Holy Spirit
      4. The Word of God
      5. Man
      6. Redemption
      7. Israel [The Chosen People of God]
      8. Eschatology [End Times]
- NOTE: You will need to write a paragraph for each of the above topics with a minimum of five sentences for each paragraph. If the passage does not address the topic, you don't have to write anything about it – however, if it does speak about it, I will know!
- h. Application [You will use the 2 Timothy 3:16 model for application “All scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, correction, for instruction in righteousness] Using the same rule as Theological Reflection, you will need to write a paragraph stating what the passage points in application in the area of doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction.
  - i. Conclusion [Summary of what you have written]

j. Bibliography [Minimum 15 Sources [Context Section]

4. The Paper will be allotted the following points:
